## Landowner Release of Liability

Limited liability for recreational or harvesting activities. Use of this property may also be used in the training of such activity, and for routine maintenance of this site.

I / We the landowner(s) have been advised of the intent of this project and understand the following:

- **The primary use of this property will be by licensed emergency rescue agencies, LifeFlight of Maine or another authorized medivac helicopter.**
- **Some modifications to the site may need to be made to accommodate the aircraft and it is understood that helicopter operations may impact the vegetation in a landing zone.**
- **The identified site may be in close proximity to residences and there may be short occurrences of louder than normal noise levels during flight operations.**
- **In the event of any activity that could interfere with the use of this rendezvous site, the landowner will advise LifeFlight of Maine (888)-421-4228, or another authorized representative of the MREA Project. An example of the aforementioned activity includes, but not limited to logging, road construction and parking of equipment.**
- **Safety/survival equipment may be placed at this site. This equipment will in no way be the responsibility of the landowner.**
- **This release does not imply permissions not detailed in this document, nor should it be regarded to be in lieu of any other land use agreement. Signing this release does not give permission to any other entity, or persons, for use of this land.**

The parties involved in the Maine Remote Emergency Access Project understand that the use of this site by LifeFlight of Maine or other authorized medivac helicopter may at some point be an inconvenience to you. On behalf of any potential person rescued from this rendezvous site, please accept our deepest appreciation for the use of your property.
