- Update on Keith Herrick our lobbyist in August.
They killed the registration bill due to needing to teach the lawmakers that this is not a request for registration increase, but to mirror the law to mirror New Hampshire. If a riders does belong to a club. then their registration fee's stay the same. If the rider does not belong to a club their registration fee's are increased by and amount yet to be determined.
